



The Gallery



The RBSA Gallery is an exhibition venue run by the Royal Birmingham Society of Artists. The Society is an artist-led charity which supports artists and promotes engagement with the visual arts through a range of exhibitions, events and workshops.

The Gallery is situated in Birmingham’s historic Jewellery Quarter, only a short walk from Birmingham City Centre and major transport links, in a converted factory building.

The Gallery is open Tuesday - Saturday between 10.30am and 5pm, admission to all our exhibitions is free.

The RBSA Gallery Shop stocks contemporary craft items, including jewellery, ceramics, textiles, prints and cards, by designer-makers based in the Midlands and beyond.

Location

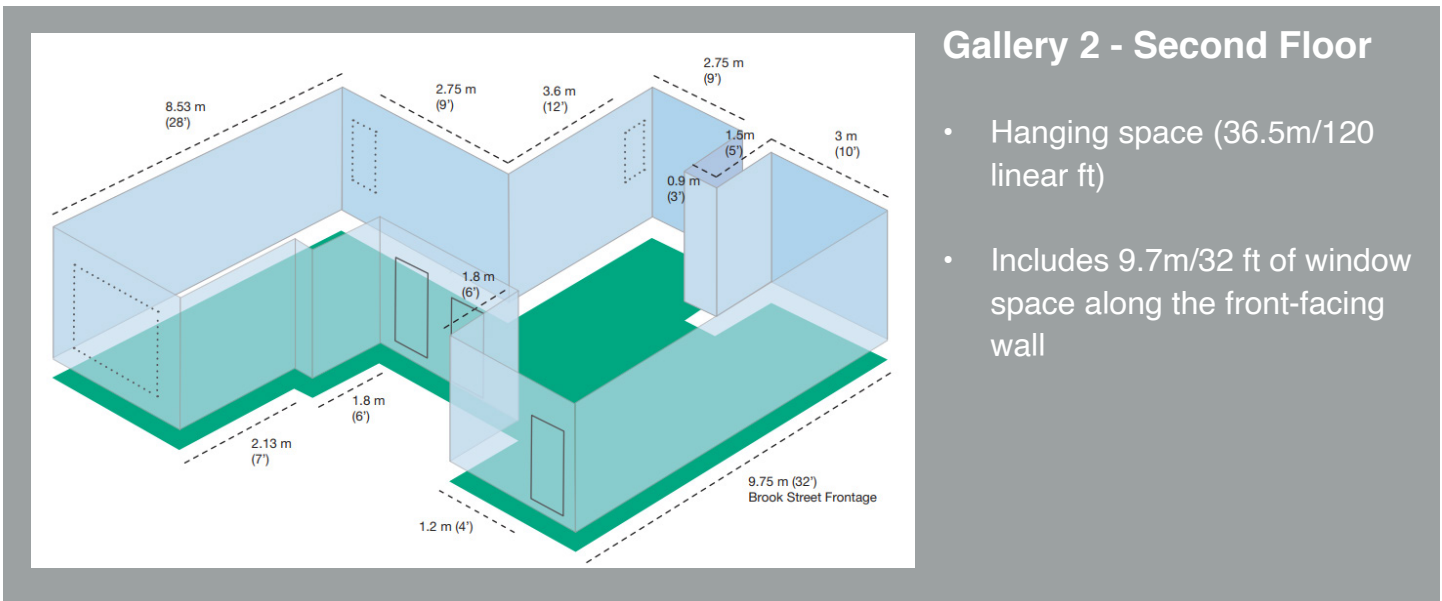
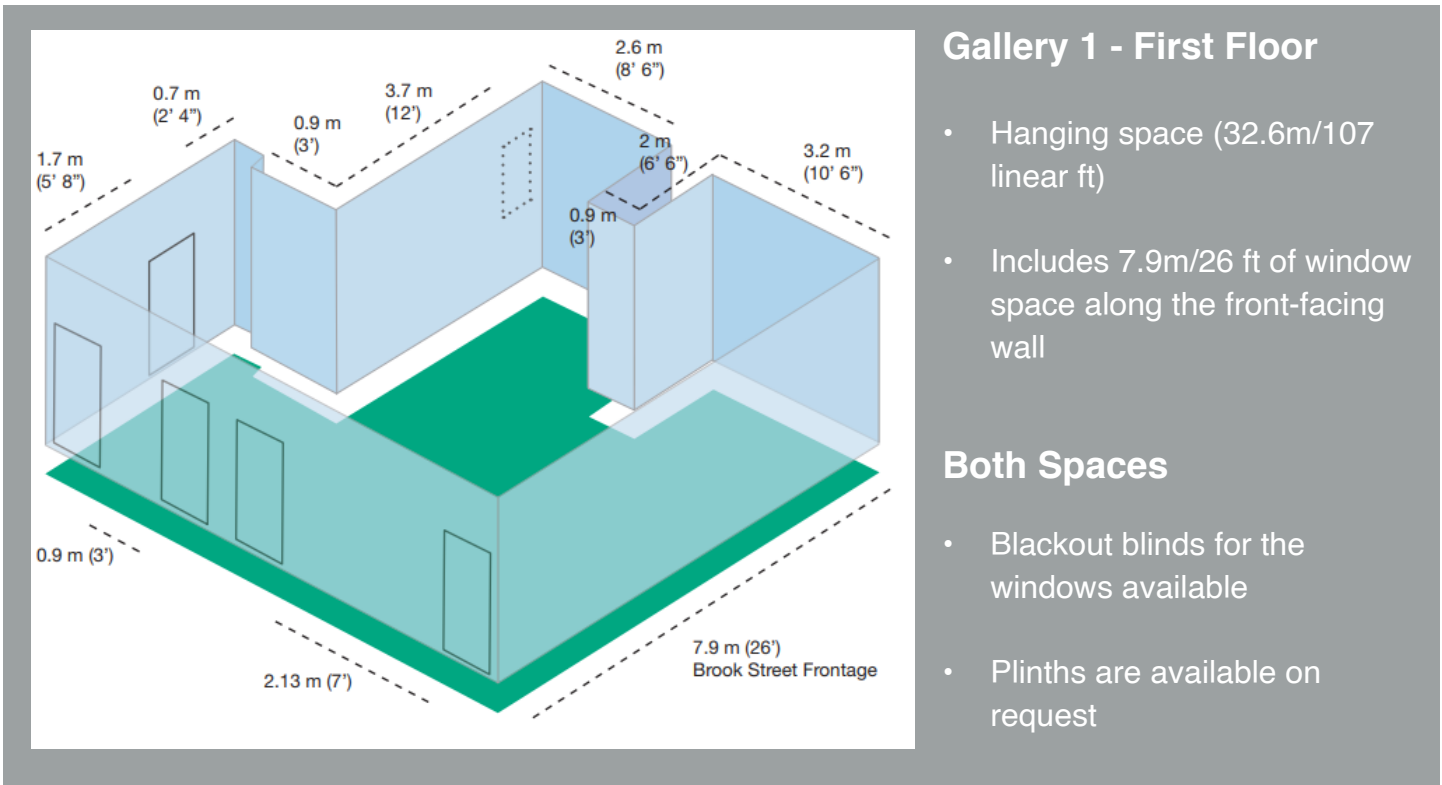
The RBSA Gallery sits just off the top of St Paul’s Square in the Jewellery Quarter with Birmingham Museum and Art Gallery only a few minutes walk away along Newhall Street.

Birmingham New Street, Moor Street and Snow Hill train stations are within an easy walking distance and meter parking is available around St Paul’s Square (free on Sundays). There is also a reasonably priced car park on Northwood Street behind the Gallery. Local bus stops are close by and the Midland Metro Tram, which passes through the city centre, stops at St Paul’s, a six minute walk away.

Gallery Spaces

The RBSA Gallery offers two spacious, versatile galleries for hire on the first and second floors. Gallery spaces can be hired individually or together by artists or groups for their own exhibitions, subject to approval of the work by the RBSA’s Exhibition Planning Group.

Both gallery spaces provide natural light from large windows, as well as having contemporary gallery lighting, and are suited for displaying both two and three-dimensional work. Power sockets are also available.

Exhibition Hire

The cost of gallery hire covers a weekly period from Sunday to Saturday. RBSA Members and Associates receive a discounted rate. The minimum hire period for exhibitions is two weeks.

Exhibitions are installed on Sundays between 1.00pm and 4.00pm and Mondays between 10.00am and 4.00pm.

Exhibitions are taken down on Sundays between 10.00am and 1.00pm.

Marketing Support

All exhibitions at the RBSA Gallery will be supported by the RBSA Gallery Marketing Department and promoted via digital and print marketing which is included in the hire fee.

This must include exhibition information, high resolution images suitable for both print and digital, and details of all social media handles.

Celebrate your exhibition with an opening Private View/reception or closing event held either in the evening or during the day. We may be able to provide light refreshments or put you in touch with a reliable local catering company should you require it.

The RBSA Gallery is also a creative space for one off meetings and corporate events which can run alongside our exhibitions. Short guided tours of the Gallery can be arranged as a unique ice-breaker for your guests.

Getting Here
Bus - The 101 bus runs from Birmingham City Centre down Newhall Street. For timetables and bus stops, please check National Express West Midlands.

Train and Metro - The RBSA Gallery is in walking distance from Snow Hill and Birmingham New Street train stations, and St Paul’s Metro Tram stop.

Car - Use any of the approach routes to Birmingham (M5, M6, M40, M42, A34, A38, A41, A456, A457) and follow signs to the city centre.

Clean Air Zone - Birmingham is now operating a Clean Air Zone in the city centre. Check if your vehicle will be charged using the Government Vehicle Checker.
